Roof Health Checkup Checklist

Inspecting Your Roof: What to Look For

Use this checklist to evaluate the health of your roof and identify any potential issues that may need repair or replacement. Regular roof inspections can save you money by catching small problems before they become major headaches.

Exterior Roof Inspection

1. Shingles

- Check for **missing, cracked, or curling shingles**.
 - *Tip:* If over 10% of the shingles are damaged, consider a professional assessment for replacement.
- Look for **granule loss** on asphalt shingles.
 - *Tip:* Excessive granule loss (found in gutters or around your home) is a sign of aging shingles.

2. Flashing & Seals

- Inspect the **flashing around chimneys, vents, and skylights**.
 - *Tip:* Flashing should be intact and free of rust or peeling.
- Ensure that **roof seals** around pipes and vents are not cracked or missing.

3. Gutters & Downspouts

- Clean out **gutters and downspouts** of any leaves, debris, and roofing granules.
 - *Tip:* Blocked gutters can lead to water pooling and potential roof damage.
- Check that the **gutters are securely attached** and not pulling away from the fascia board.

4. Fascia & Soffits

- Examine the **fascia boards for signs of rot, peeling paint, or damage**.

- Check **soffits** (under-roof eaves) for signs of mold, mildew, or animal nests.

5. Roof Surface

- Look for any **sagging or dipping areas** on the roof.

- Inspect for **moss, mold, or algae growth** on the roof surface.

Interior Roof Inspection

2. Sunlight Penetration

- During the day, **look for any sunlight coming through the roof** boards.
 - *Tip:* Sunlight means holes or cracks that should be sealed immediately.

1. Schedule Regular Inspections

- Inspect your roof **twice a year** (Spring and Fall) and after severe weather events.

2. Trim Overhanging Branches

- **Trim back trees and branches** that are close to or touch your roof.
 - *Tip:* Overhanging branches can damage shingles and create a pathway for pests.

3. Clean & Maintain Gutters

- **Clean gutters and downspouts** regularly to ensure proper drainage.

4. Monitor for Ice Dams (in Cold Climates)

- During winter, **watch for ice build-up on the roof's edge**, known as ice dams.
 - *Tip:* Ice dams can cause water to back up under shingles, leading to leaks.

Roof Health Scorecard

Use this simple scoring system to determine the overall health of your roof.

- **0-5 Issues Found:** **Excellent Condition** - Minimal repairs needed.
- **6-10 Issues Found:** **Moderate Condition** - Schedule minor repairs and routine maintenance.
- **11+ Issues Found:** **Poor Condition** - Consider a professional inspection for repair or replacement.

Take Action

If you identify any issues during your inspection, prioritize repairs based on urgency:

1. **Leaks & Structural Damage** - Immediate professional attention required.
2. **Damaged Shingles or Flashing** - Repair or replace before the next severe weather season.
3. **Gutter & Fascia Maintenance** - Clean, repair, or replace as needed.

By regularly checking and maintaining your roof, you can prevent small issues from becoming major, costly repairs and extend the lifespan of your roofing materials.
